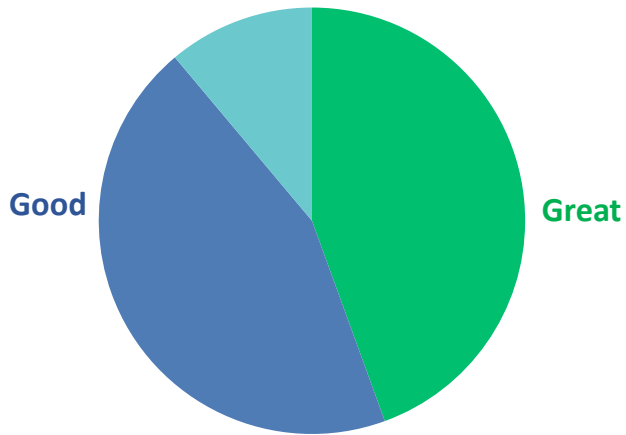
Board Meeting Evaluation

The meeting package was received with sufficient time to allow me to prepare.

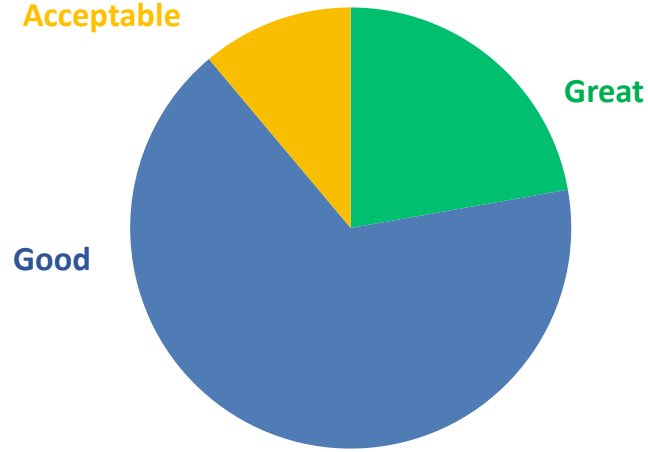
Needs Improvement



For new Board members, it would be useful to receive additional briefing information about some agenda items.

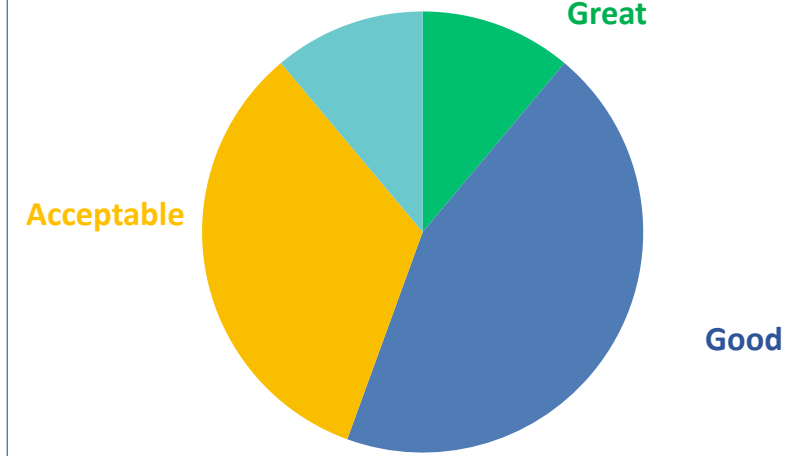
The agenda items and materials were appropriate to the Committee and the Board's role, and the materials were sufficient to assist me in forming opinions on matters before the Committee/Board.

Time was used effectively, and discussions were focused.

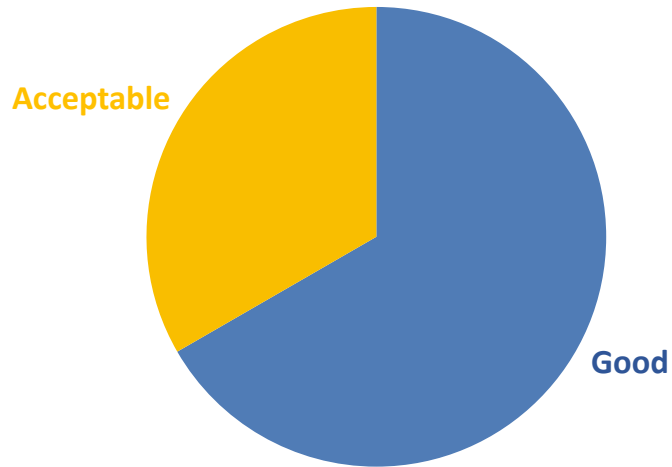
Needs Improvement



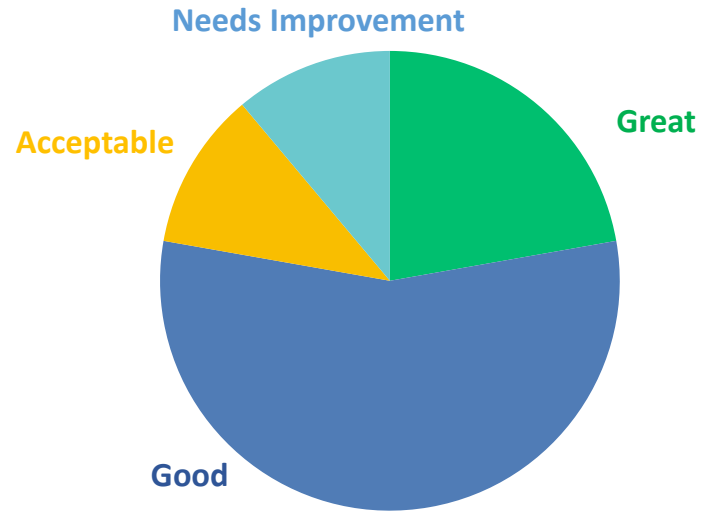
We could have used more time to discuss the last agenda item.



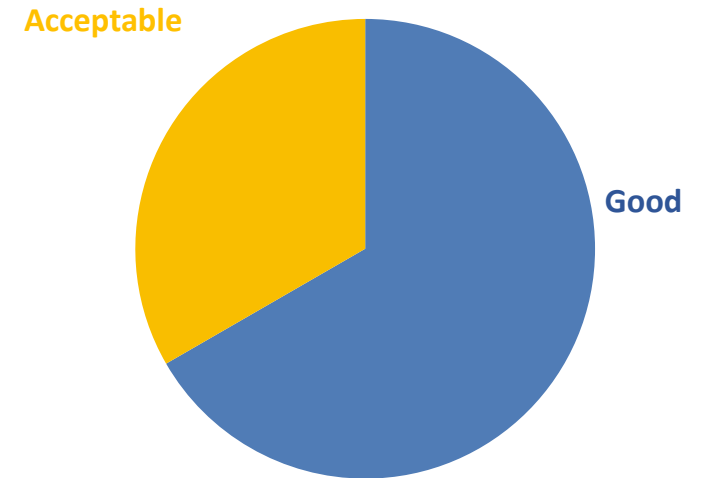
Board discussions and deliberations remained centred on the public interest, and we avoided getting into administrative and operational management details.

Where appropriate, next steps and action items were clearly identified.

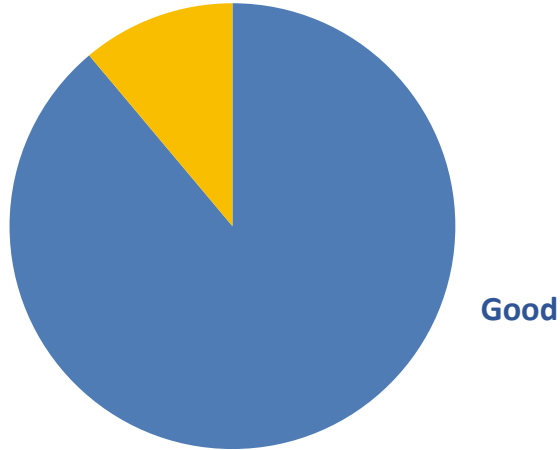


The discussions about the limited class of license were challenging and difficult at times.



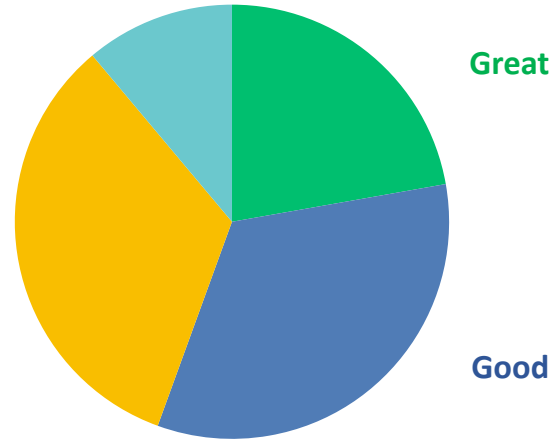
Directors appeared prepared for the meeting.

Acceptable



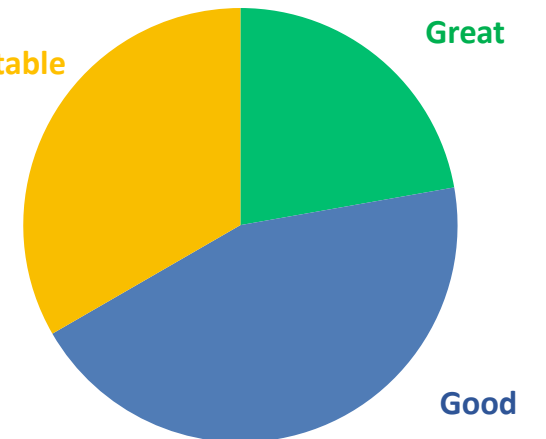
I was satisfied with the opportunities that all of us had to participate in and contribute to the discussion and debate.
