

April 21, 2020 - Update from Leeds, Grenville and Lanark District Health Unit about COVID-19 Vaccinations

Staff fits in the high priority group to receive a COVID-19 vaccination, as noted in page 12 of [Guidance for Prioritizing Health Care Workers for COVID-19 Vaccination](#).

Staff are invited to one of Leeds, Grenville and Lanark District's 4 COVID-19 Fixed Vaccination Clinics. Please know that these sites are by invitation only. Please do not share this invitation with anyone else beyond you and your staff.

All staff must bring their OHIP card and a piece of ID (registration card or letter from their employer) as proof that they meet the eligibility criteria for this category.

Pfizer vaccines will be provided at these sites only. Individuals needing their second dose of the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine can book a well, as long as there has been 16 weeks since their first dose. Please do not book into the fixed sites if you need a second dose of Moderna.

Clinic Locations:

- The North Grenville Municipality Centre
 - The parking lot and entrance is located at the back of the centre. Please do not enter at the front entrance of the building
- Almonte General Hospital (co-located with the Almonte COVID-19 Assessment Centre)
 - In the Octagon Room
 - The parking lot is at the back of the hospital
- Brockville Memorial Centre
- Smiths Falls Memorial Centre

If all appointments are full, please check the website frequently in the event that more appointment slots become available. However, staff aged 40+ can also choose to book through pharmacies or primary care. Please reach out to your local pharmacy or primary care office for access to the Astra Zeneca vaccine. What to Do Prior and Upon Arrival:

- Before you attend the clinic, please complete the [provincial self – assessment screening tool](#). If it recommends getting tested, please cancel your immunization appointment and rebook after you have received a negative test and are feeling better. Information on how to cancel your appointment will be provided to you when you book
- Arrive at your designated time and do not arrive earlier
- Wear a short-sleeved top
- Bring your OHIP card with you
- Ensure that you maintain proper physical distancing from all others
- A mask is required to enter the building
